

**PROPOSED CHANGES TO WATER
QUALITY STANDARDS
LAC DU FLAMBEAU BAND OF
LAKE SUPERIOR CHIPPEWA INDIANS
PUBLIC NOTICE AND REQUEST FOR COMMENTS**

The Lac du Flambeau Tribal Water Resource Program is seeking comments on any potential changes to the Lac du Flambeau Tribe's current Water Quality Standards. Currently, the Program is proposing to update human health criteria to the most current values established by the EPA but also welcomes comments on other parts of the Tribe's water quality standards. It is proposed to adopt the EPA updates that are more stringent than the existing criteria. In instances where the EPA updates are less stringent than existing, no changes are proposed.
