TRIBAL CODE

CHAPTER 46:

CONSUMER PROTECTION ORDINANCE

46.101 Incorporation of Wisconsin Consumer Act.

The provisions of the Wisconsin Consumer Act, Wis. Stat. Chapters 421 to 427, and any rules or orders of any Wisconsin administrative agency promulgated thereunder, are hereby incorporated as tribal law as if fully set forth herein.

46.102 Incorporation of Trade Regulations.

The provisions of Wis. Stat. sec. 100.18, fraudulent representations, and Wis. Stat. sec. 100.20, methods of competition and trade practices, and any rules or orders of the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection promulgated thereunder, are hereby incorporated in tribal law as if fully set forth herein.

46.103 Tribal Court Jurisdiction.

The tribal court shall have jurisdiction over all cases arising under sec. 46.101 and 46.102 where the transaction or occurrence giving rise to the cause of action arose within the Lac du Flambeau Reservation and:

- (1) The defendant is a tribal member, a tribal member business, an Indian person enrolled in another tribe, or a business owned by such Indian person; or
- (2) The plaintiff meets the requirements of sub. (1) and the defendant does business upon the reservation with the Tribe, a tribal member, or a tribal member business.
