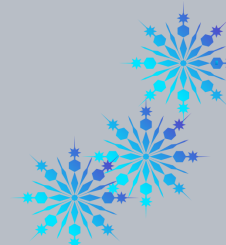
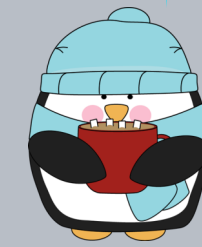

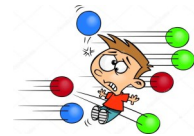

Last two pages of the yc handbook filled out and returned are required for admittance to the yc!

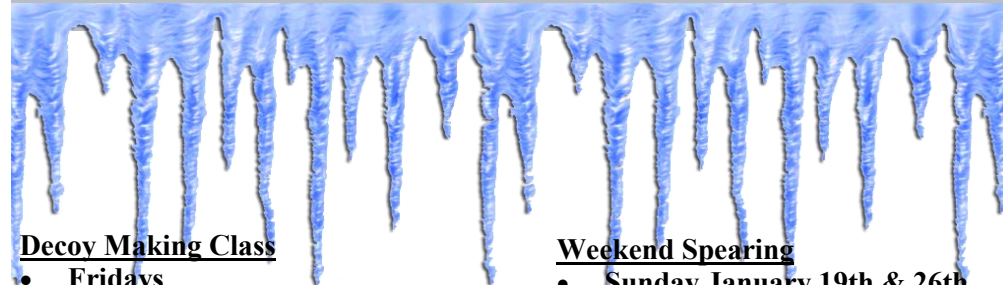
